Amica of the Year Award for 2008

~CRITERIA ~

The Amica of the Year Award is a special honor to receive as a member of the Amicae Auxiliary of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. This award is given to an Amicae member who has shown exemplary headship, excellent moral conduct and work ethics, outstanding community involvement, and hard work as well as passion towards her fellow Amicae and people in need. The nominee must meet certain criteria in order to be nominated.

The qualification for Amica of the Year includes membership of an Amicae Auxiliary for at least 2 years, financial, and active participation since her initiation or for the past year. In addition, she must personify Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. Founding Principles of Finer Womanhood, Service, Sisterhood, and Scholarship. She must serve as a positive role model amongst her peers, help other people excel, and demonstrate productivity within her community.

The recipient must be present at the [74th Regional Conference in Indianapolis, Indiana April 17, 2008](#).

Nominees must demonstrate the following characteristics:

- Initiative, contribution, leadership ability, dedication, knowledge, managerial skills, teamwork, and performance)

Nominees must submit the following requirements:

- Nomination form signed by the Amicae President and Zeta Chapter President/designee
- Submit a 300 words or less essay, "What Does Being an Amica Means to Me?" (written by the nominee)

The entries will be judged by a special committee, which will include both Zetas and Amicae selected by the Regional Amicae Coordinator. Entries must be received via email, fax, or "snail" mail no later than April 12, 2008. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Therefore, you must allow 5 to 7 days via regular US Postal Service to deliver your entry by April 5th.
